

- X Discuss expectations at the beginning of the year so students know what is expected
- X Create a welcoming space and a sense of belonging

POSITIVITY


- X Correct and direct in a positive way

- X Positive mindset!





TRUST

- X If students trust teachers, they tend to work harder in class, ask questions, and come to their teacher to discuss schoolwork or social life
- Students who have poor adult connections in the past may have a difficult time trusting teachers, so it is important to work on building trust through a positive relationship
